Airlines Flight 243 Boeing 737-200 April 28,1988 ... - 26 Oct 2015 - ZS-OAA, 737-400, Comair, MLG collapse on landing at Johannesburg, South Africa. The F/O flared at 65 feet (instead of the recommended 20 feet) resulting in a long landing. Following touch down excessive vibrations built up which resulted in the upper torsion link failure.
