Skin The skin and hairs and other structures such as nails constitute the integumentary system. The principal parts of the skin are the superficial epidermis and deeper dermis. The dermis overlies and attaches to the subcutaneous (subQ) layer. Epidermal cells include keratinocytes, melanocytes, Langerhans cells, and Tactile cells.
